

The Arts Society Trent Valley
Visit to Sledmere House
Tuesday, August 6th 2019

Originally built in the 1750s, this Classic Georgian house suffered a catastrophic fire in 1911, but was carefully rebuilt and restored under the direction of soldier, diplomat and orientalist Sir Mark Sykes.

It survives today as a most fitting home for the family collection of art and antiques.

The gardens are renowned for their seasonal interest and inspired planting.

There is an eighteenth century walled garden along with individual smaller gardens including a highly acclaimed vegetable potager and ornamental fruit garden.

We shall travel by Hammonds Coach for the two and a half hour journey, with a stop en route.

8.00am Depart Radcliffe on Trent from the bus stop by Tomkins, the Butchers.

10.30am Arrive at Sledmere, where coffee will be available.

Private Guided Tour of the House followed by a short garden visit.

There are several options for lunch, the price of which is not included on the booking form.

After lunch, AS Trent member, Paul Hale, former Organist at Southwell Minster, will give a short organ recital.
